Shipwrecked

Jeremiah 29:11-14a (NASB) – ‘For I know the plans that I have for you,’ declares the Lord, ‘plans for *welfare* & not for *calamity* to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon Me and come & pray to Me, and I will listened to you. You will seek Me & find Me when you search for Me with all your heart. I will be found by you,’ declares the Lord.

Welfare = *shalom* = peace

Calamity = *rahh* = evil

GOØD [GOOD GOD]

ØEVIL [EVIL DEVIL]

Jeremiah 1:5 – “I knew you before I formed you in your mother’s womb. Before you were born I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations.”

Ephesians 1:4 –Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes.

1 Timothy 2:4-6a – who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, & one mediator also between God & men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself as a ransom for all.
